Rolf Muller, Ph.D. is co-founder of Biomatrix and serves as its Chief Scientific Officer. Rolf has more than 10 years of experience in starting biotechnology companies and is an expert in high throughput genomics and proteomics technologies. He was most recently the Director of Assay Development and High Throughput at the Scripps Research Institute where he was responsible for the development of high throughput small molecule drug screens. Prior to his position at Scripps, he served as Director of Molecular Biology at HK Pharmaceuticals, where he assisted in establishing the company and conceptualized the drug discovery process. Before HK, Rolf was the Director of the Total Gene Expression Analysis Services Department at Digital Gene Technologies and was responsible for scientific direction, including industrial scale gene discovery, database mining and bioinformatics integration. He also served as a scientist at the Salk Institute studying cell signaling and viral based gene therapy approaches. Rolf holds a doctorate in biochemistry and molecular virology from the Pasteur Institute in Paris, France, and a B.S. in agricultural biology from the Universität Stuttgart-Hohenheim in Germany. He is the author of numerous publications and patents.
